



### 6U Tee Ball Special Rules

- Maximum of 5 Runs in an inning.
- Games will be 5 Innings.
- Hour & 30 minute-time limit. No new inning after an hour 30 minutes.
- In Tee-ball, time will be called when the pitcher is in the circle with the ball.
- Home team is decided by Coin Flip.
- A new inning will be started when the final out is made in the previous inning. **Example:** If there are three seconds left when the final out is made, we will start a new inning.
- If a game is tied after the home team has batted, and there is no time left on the clock, we will play a modified international tiebreaker rule where last batted out starts on 2<sup>nd</sup> base with no outs. Both teams will get to bat in this scenario, and if game is still tied after one inning, it will be deemed a tie ballgame. **In year-end league tournament**, we will repeat this process until there is a winner.
- Both Score keepers (home and away) are to sit in the press box behind home plate.
- **BAT RULE: ONLY BATS WITH A USA STAMP ARE APPROVED OR ANY BAT LABELED AS "TEE BALL"**
- The home team is the official book and is to also keep the scoreboard.  
(Adults only in the press box)
- **NO NAMES ON THE BACK OF JERSEYS**

### DEFENSIVE RULES

- ONE COACH ON THE FIELD AND MUST STAND IN OUTFIELD BEHIND GRASS IN FOUL TERRITORY.
- ONLY 5 (FIVE) PLAYERS ON THE INFIELD- EVERYONE ELSE MUST BE IN THE GRASS.

(PITCHER, 3<sup>RD</sup>, SHORTSTOP, 2<sup>ND</sup>, 1<sup>ST</sup>).

- EVERYONE ON DEFENSE MUST BE BEHIND THE SAFETY LINE BEFORE THE BALL IS HIT.
- NO CATCHER.
- ROLLING THE BALL IS NOT ALLOWED. PLAYERS SHOULD **MAKE EFFORT** TO THROW THE BASEBALL.
- A PLAYER MAY HAND THE BALL TO THE PITCHER WHILE THE PITCHER IS IN THE CIRCLE TO STOP PLAY.

### OFFENSIVE COACHES

- ONE COACH ON FIRST BASE, ONE ON THIRD BASE, ONE AT THE TEE. BASE COACHES MAY NOT TOUCH OR ASSIST THE RUNNERS.
